
Re: Correction to ARRB *Follow-up Report* 19 December 1996

In our pre Christmas conversation, I related that there was difficulty ascertaining the manufacturing date of the Ektachrome E3 roll film contained on page 7 of my report and we left the date blank.

This paragraph reads:

"Edge print: Edge print marking showed S^oAFETY FILM and several frame numbers 4-7 etc. and the number -- 03095. These markings identify the film as EKTACHROME E3 Daylight Type, Film Code 6003, emulsion batch 095, manufactured in Rochester / /."

We have now confirmed that the coating records for that phase of production are lost. We have records that show that the last batch-6003 041 - of the previous phase was coated 12/29/60, and that 6003 109 which began the subsequent phase coated 4/6/64. If production were uniform during the intervening period, we could extrapolate that emulsion batch 095 was coated in the summer or fall of 1963.
